

FAQ's

Can these units be cut?

Yes, by using a saw the units can be cut. Be sure to keep at least one connection point.

What size gravel do I need?

$\frac{3}{4}$ " clean(washed) angular gravel is recommended for base.
 $\frac{1}{2}$ " or smaller gravel is recommended for the unit's aggregate fill.

What size base do I need?

If used for driving on, 2"-3" of gravel base under units. If used for only pedestrian traffic, no base is needed.

Do I need to anchor the units?

Anchoring units is only necessary on slopes, if units are not embedded within the ground or areas where vehicle tires turn often. We recommend using Vodaland EasyPave/HexPave anchors or J-Hook rebar anchors.

Can I snow plow over these?

Yes, simply ensure the plow is set to the correct height, not digging into the units.

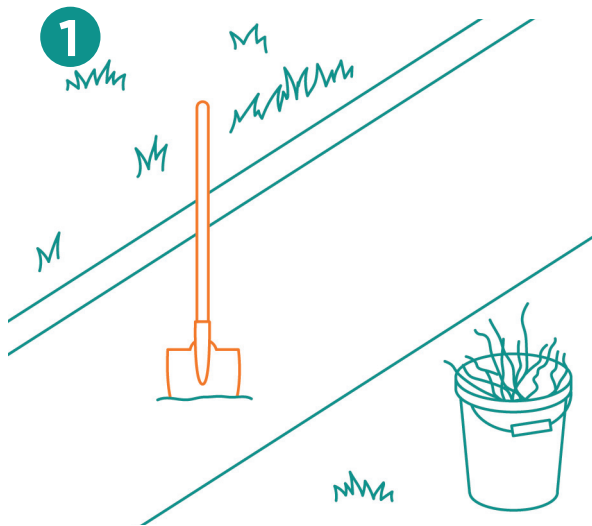

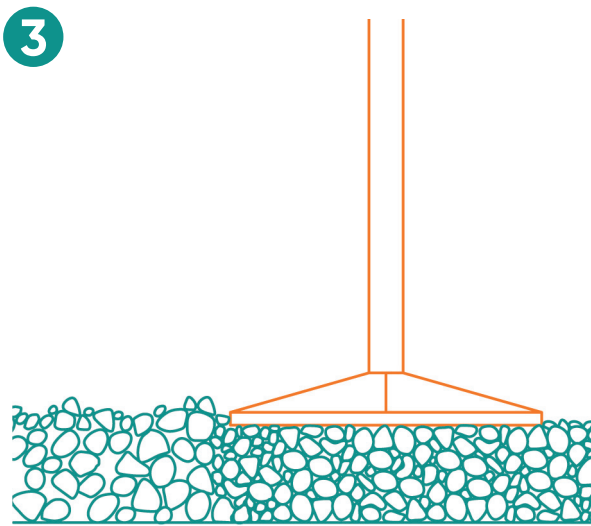


Pavers Installation Guide

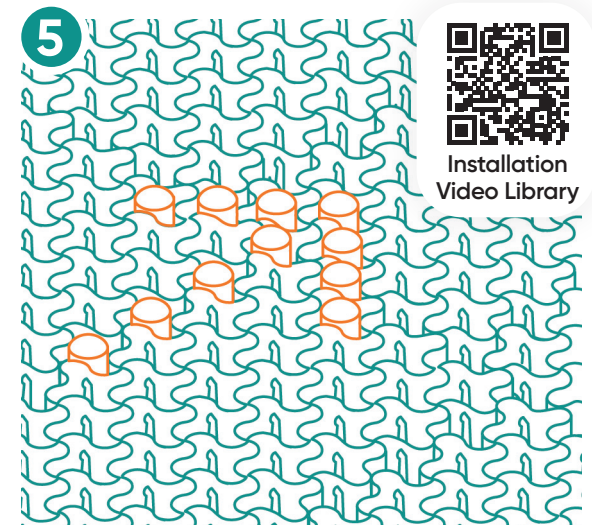




1 Dig to the depth needed for your type of installation (in FAQs). Smooth out installation area. Remove any rocks or debris.

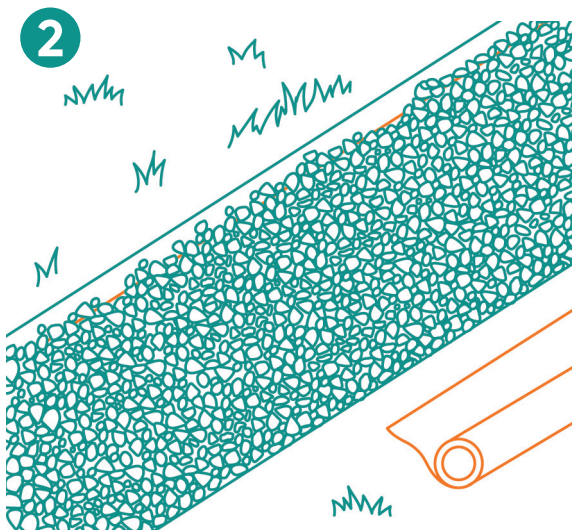


3 Compact base with either hand tamp, vehicle or plat compressor.

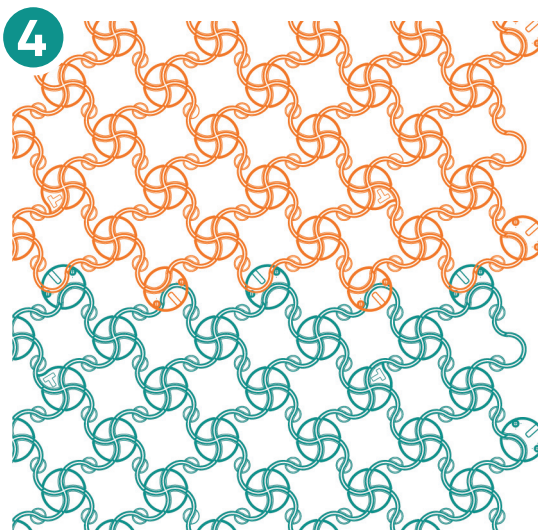

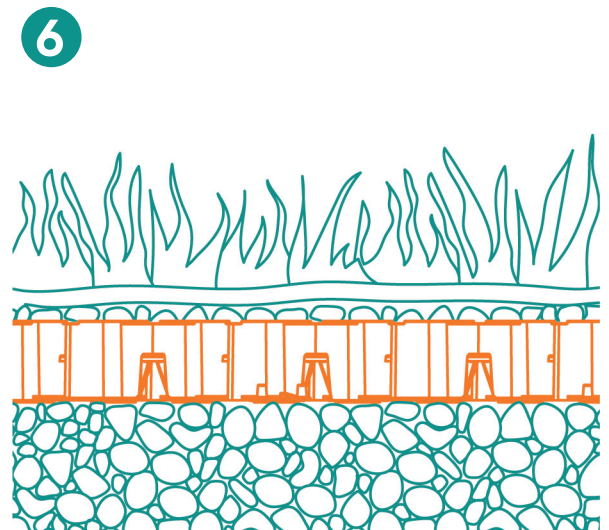
5 Anchor units and/or add easy spots where needed.



2 Place GeoTextile or weed barrier down and add base layer of gravel.



4 Connect grid over base, ensuring every unit is in the same pattern.



6 Add aggregate fill to units, (soil, sand, gravel, etc.). Then lightly compact area. Add seed or sod on top if growing grass.
